Inventory of Goods & chattles belonging to the Estate of James F. Huggins Deed. Return to May Court 1847. Also the articles sold by Special Administration viz the articles not sold, Spinning wheel, Pine press, Bureau, two Mallets, nine timber gages, pot rack, pair of shoes, three barrels, Featle, three jugs, two coffee pots, butter pot, duckbill, clock how, hay, two sifles, knife box, basket, shovel, bread haw, eyed iron, little pan, poker, pot hooks, one flat iron, iron fork, tribute, raw hide, quorn and half gallon of salt, three pales, frame, hammer adds pair of wedges, chest, seven chairs, three ruddles two boxes, one and a half lbs of soap, Cag half fall of white lead, pigger, ston, two pots, two grubbing hows, five weeding hows, five axes, grindstone, crows, seven iron boxes, tin bucket, Box of tools, wood square, two beds and some furniture, three rees, tub, painted press, five plates, three bottles, three snuff bottles, two decanters, gel pot, dish, tumbler, five cups & three saucers, mug, cream pot, Pitcher, little basket, bole, four knives & four forks, four spoons, two barrels of corn, toorn and case.
